

Ringgold County Board of Supervisors Minutes

April 4, 2022

The Ringgold County Board of Supervisors met in regular session Monday, April 4, 2022. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 A.M with the following members present Ron Landphair, Colby Holmes and Steve Knapp.

A motion was made by Holmes, second by Knapp to approve the agenda.

Engineer Jared Johnson met with the Board to provide secondary roads updates. The excavator brush grinder has been working to cut/mulch trees and brush encroaching the roadway in the North Central and Northeast maintainer districts.

The skid loader brush grinder has been working to cut/mulch trees and brush encroaching the roadway in the Northwest, North Central, and Northeast maintainer districts.

Snow fence installed along J23 was removed and placed into storage.

The crew was out cutting brush around signs and bridge ends.

The crew worked to prepare materials for the summer construction season.

Spot rock was hauled to the North Central and Northeast maintainer districts.

Blades were out working on roads when conditions allowed.

The crew was out with the skid loader repairing potholes on posted bridges, which maintainers cannot cross.

The sign truck was out working to repair/replace deteriorated and/or damaged signs. The face flashing "Stop Ahead" signs were installed at the P27/HWY 2 intersection.

The crew worked on the J23 detour signage for the upcoming Grant 1 bridge maintenance project. This project is scheduled to begin near the end of June, however, detour signs will be erected ahead of time and covered until the detour route is needed.

Pay voucher number 7 for the Redding weir project (\$5726.88) was submitted to the Iowa DOT for payment.

A preconstruction meeting for the J23 and P64 seal coat projects has been scheduled for Thursday, April 7th, at the Ringgold County Engineer's office.

All clearances for the Benton 11 project have been obtained. The department will begin to negotiate Right-of-Way once the acquisition plats are received. The department is working on plan development for the project.

Treasurer Debra Cannon met with the Board to request assignment of county held tax sale on Parcel 009468.

The Board reviewed claims to be paid Wednesday, April 6.
